Admissions Consultation on proposed changes to Lionheart Educational Trust Beauchamp City Sixth Form Admission Arrangements for the 2026-2027 school year. Period of Consultation: Monday 4th November 2024 to Friday 20th December 2024

As part of Lionheart Educational Trust, from Monday 4th November until Friday 20th December 2024 Beauchamp City Sixth Form will be consulting on proposed changes to 2026-2027 admission arrangements. All schools/academies/colleges must have admission arrangements that clearly set out how children will be admitted, including information about what happens if there are more applications than places available (oversubscription criteria). The criteria must be reasonable, clear, objective, and procedurally fair and comply with all relevant legislation, including equalities legislation. It is for the admissions authority (Lionheart Educational Trust) to decide which criteria are most suitable for the school/academy according to local circumstances.

The Proposed Changes:

Beauchamp City Sixth Form are consulting on changing their oversubscription criteria, outlined in appendix 1, and inline with the code of admissions.

All changes are outlined in appendix 1.

These are the only proposed changes.

Who are we consulting with?

The School Admissions Code 2021 requires that all admission authorities undertake a statutory consultation to seek the views and comments of parents/carers, other admission authorities, schools in the relevant area, Leicester City and County Council including neighbouring local authorities and anyone else who may be affected by the proposed changes.
